### This warranty does not cover:


- General cleaning and maintenance






# AUSFILE® Tambour Door Cabinet Levelling Instructions



Your AUSFILE® Tambour door cupboard is designed to meet the most demanding of commercial environments. Your cupboard is fitted with adjustable feet which can be accessed from inside the unit. These feet allow your cupboard to be levelled where your floor may be uneven, making your cupboard appear to be out of line with your walls or other furniture. We recommend that your cupboard is levelled before loading the shelves. We have provided an Allen Key to assist you in levelling your cupboard.

- A Plastic Caps
- B Opening in base shelf to access adjustable feet
- C Allen Key




**STEP 1**  
Remove the plastic plug (A) in the corner that needs to be raised. (In this example, the front right hand corner)

**STEP 2**  
Put the Allen Key (C) through the hole (B) and engage the top of the adjustable foot (approximately 35mm below the shelf level). Turn the Allen Key clockwise to adjust the foot down. You will see the unit lift.

**STEP 3**  
Replace the plastic plug (A) and repeat the process for any other corner that requires adjusting

# AUSFILE® Tambour Door Cabinet Installing/Adjusting the shelves



Your AUSFILE® Tambour door cupboard is fitted with shelves which are adjustable in increments of 25mm. The shelf clips are designed to grip the edge of shelves and provide a positive lock to the inner side panels of the cupboard. The diagram below shows how the shelf clips are to be fitted. You may notice that your cupboard has been delivered with the shelves pre-fitted with 4 white plastic retaining clips holding each shelf in place, these are to prevent your shelves from becoming dislodged during the delivery process and can be discarded if desired.

- A Shelf
- B Shelf Clip
- C Shelf clip slots in side panels
- D Plastic shelf retaining clip

**STEP 1**  
Remove the 4 x plastic shelf retaining clips (D) (1 in each corner on the top side of shelf) if fitted

**STEP 2**  
Tilt one end of shelf (A) as shown above and lift shelf out of cupboard

**STEP 3**  
Remove the shelf clips (B) and re-install at the desired height as shown to the right

**STEP 4**  
Place the shelf (A) over the clips (B) so that the edge of the shelf engages with the clip (B).

**PLEASE NOTE:**

The adjustable and base shelves are slotted to accept a shelf dividing kit which comprises of a divided shelf back and 3 dividers (for a 900 wide unit) or 4 dividers (for a 1200 wide unit). These dividers are to accommodate colour coded files and mailla folder storage. These divider kits are available as an accessory from your Profile distributor.
